Project Leader – Beyond is a fixed term appointment of 12 months to support the Assistant Chief Commissioner - Youth to implement and facilitate the Beyond Initiative. It seeks to broaden the roles available and the mindset of young leaders to ensure all the skills, knowledge and ability cultivated in their time as youth members is not lost when they are looking for their next challenge. Due to the multifaceted involvement of the Beyond Initiative, additional support is needed to coordinate, finalise and facilitate the program to the benefit of all members. This role will also conduct the administration functions of the Beyond Initiative.

### PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES


In conjunction with the Assistant Chief Commissioner – Youth.

- Be the first point of contact for enquiries relating to Beyond.
- Receive, acknowledge and collate questions, participant suggestions, prospective roles and other significant items relating to the Beyond Initiative.
- Liaise with young leaders (Rovers and other young members looking for their next challenge) to find a role they are interested in which makes best use of their time, skills, knowledge and abilities.
- Liaise with Group, District, Region and State teams to support young leaders utilising the Beyond
- Liaise with Victorian Rovers to ensure the Beyond Initiative is promoted and accessed.
- Promote, coordinate, facilitate and support the Beyond Initiative with the support of the Assistant Chief Commissioner Youth.
- Maintain and update the Beyond webpages on the Scouts Victoria website.
- Provide general support to the Beyond Initiative.
